

Uberto was born from a family of musicians, his father Salvatore was a composer, his mother Mila a pianist. After obtaining his Flute Diploma, Uberto continued his studies with Severino Gazzelloni, Roberto Fabbriciani, Adelio Alfieri and Mario Ancillotti. He studied composition with Gaetano Giani Luporini in Florence, Orchestra Conducting in Turin with Giorgio Ferrari and Computer Music in Venice and in Paris with Pierre Boulez.

In his long and successful career as a soloist Uberto has recorded, broadcasted and performed all across the world, including Europe, Russia, the USA and Central America, Africa, India, Japan and the Far East.

Uberto is Professor of Flute, Chamber Music, and Music for Wind Ensembles and in his long career he has taught in several Conservatories of Music as well as in independent music schools and has given Master Classes worldwide. Uberto explored and integrated many different cultures into his playing and teaching, from Zen and Aiki-Do to Yoga, from poetry, theatre and cinema to languages.
